1.	<p>Female 87y</p> <p>Cyst lower right 3,4 region Previously treated 6 years ago Biopsy of cyst lining. Cavity filled with cream cheese like material.</p>	
2.	<p>Female 14y</p> <p>Bilateral Mandibular swelling.</p>	
3.	<p>Male 36y</p> <p>Radiolucency lower border mandible explored 4 years previously. Bony palpable swelling lower border lower right 7,6 area</p>	
4.	<p>Male 27y</p> <p>Tumour in left temporal bone going into infratemporal fossa and superiorly into middle cranial fossa</p>	
5.	<p>Male 28y</p> <p>Swelling right nose</p>

6.	<p>Male 18y</p> <p>Swelling right side mandible. Large radiolucent area duration 3/12 ?ameloblastoma.</p>	
7.	<p>Female 30y</p> <p>Excisional biopsy gingival swelling Present 3 years. Painless, increasing in size. Clinically ?pyogenic granuloma ?gingival hyperplasia.</p>
